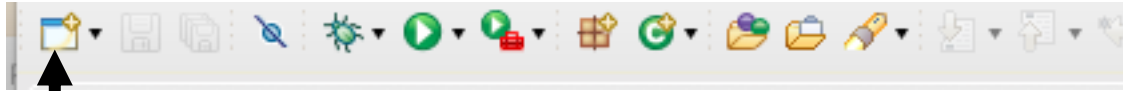
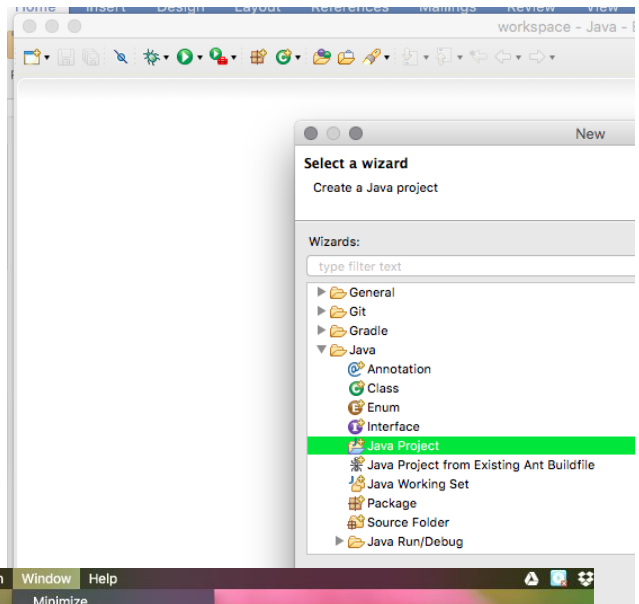


How to run PhET activities on a Mac Air

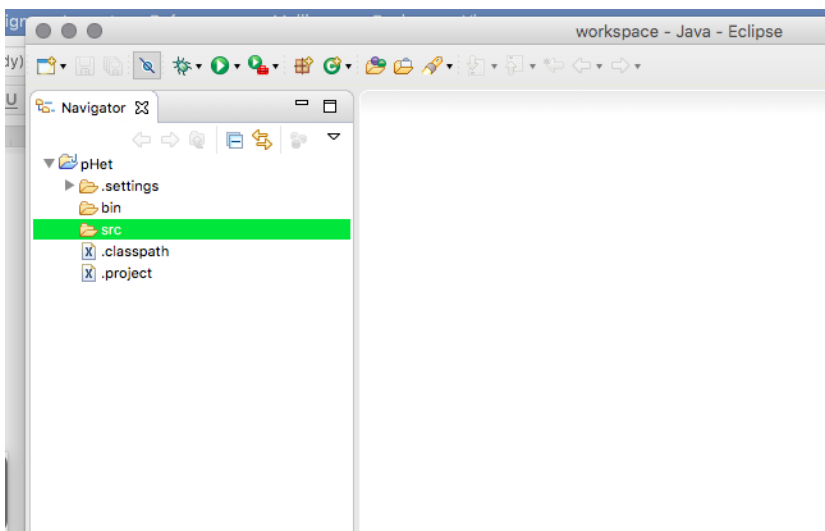
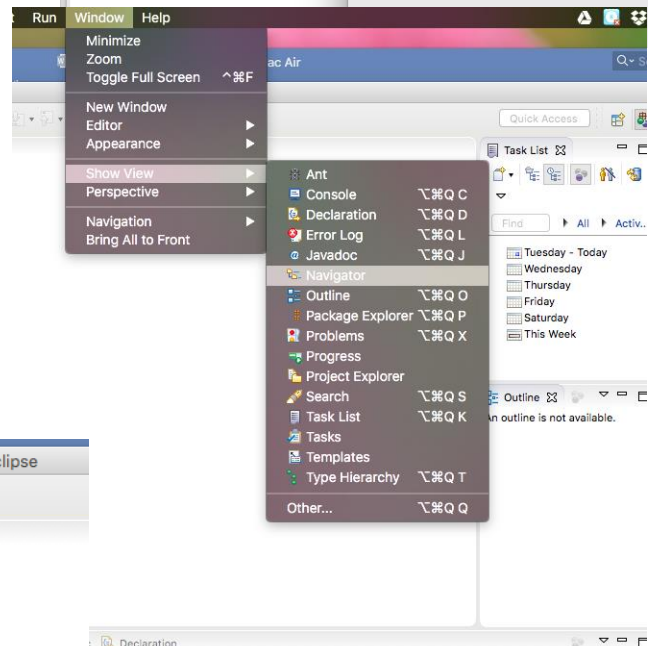
1. Log into Self Service and download Eclipse Java
2. Open Eclipse, if it doesn't open automatically, open Finder and then Applications to find Eclipse program.
3. Once open, check the box, use this as default... and then click OK
4. Once program opens, X out of the welcome screen.
5. Click on the first icon in the upper left hand corner.



6. Select Java folder, then Java Project



7. Click Next.
8. Under Project Name type, PhET
9. Click Finish
10. We now have to get the toolbar to show up.
11. At the very top of your MAC, select Window, Show View, then Navigation.



12. A phet folder will appear on the left, open it and then open the src (source) folder.

13. Now let's find the PhET file that was downloaded
14. In Finder, click on download to locate the downloaded PhET file.
15. Click and drag the PhET file from downloads over the src folder.
16. Double click on the src folder and the PhET file will appear.
17. Click on the PhET file in the src folder to run.
18. The PhET program should now run.
